Sermon #1088 The Problem of Evil (Part 2) concerns and relay requests to God in prayer. Being made in the image of God elevates us far above even the most sophisticated animals.

Being made in God's image means we can know right and wrong. When a lion kills a wildebeest, steals from a hyena, eats one of its young, or has multiple mates, we do not label it evil or guilty of wrongdoing, but when man steals, kills, abuses a child, or is unfaithful to his mate, we see these acts as moral failures. We also have the capacity to love and to forgive our enemies. After someone inflicts an injury on you, you can pause, reflect, and choose to take the high road; animals cannot.

We learn further in 1 John 1:3 that man may have "fellowship ... with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ..." Jesus says in John 15:4, "Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me." What a blessing to be made in the image of God, and yet, what tremendous responsibility!
