to see that light pass by the sun's limb." Viewing the sun and the stars from Brazil during the total solar eclipse confirmed Einstein's theory and made him instantly famous.

In the process, Einstein shattered the previously held view of "astronomers and physicists that the universe was infinitely old." By confirming that the universe was finite, it also forced the scientific community to accept that what had been contradicted from Genesis 1 about the existence of a beginning had now been overwhelmingly confirmed – by science! Ross drives home the implications: "[S]pace and time were created. Space and time had a beginning. Which means there must be an agent beyond space and time that created our universe of matter, energy, space and time." This moved astronomer Hugh Ross to accept the God of the Bible and become a follower of Jesus Christ. Ross insists, "There's nothing we can be more confident of than the reliability of the Theory of General Relativity. Which means that likewise we have confidence that there must be a God beyond space and time who created our universe."
